

Neighbourhood CIL: Reporting by Town/Parish Councils

- Regulation 121B of the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended) sets out that local councils must prepare a report for any financial year (“the reported year”) in which it receives Neighbourhood CIL receipts.
- The reported year refers to the period between 1st of April and 31st of March each year.
- It should be noted that ‘receives’ refers to the date on which the Neighbourhood CIL funds are transferred from Waverley Borough Council to the relevant Town or Parish Council.
- The Waverley Borough Council CIL Team have produced the template overleaf to assist you with your duties under Regulation 121B of the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended).
- In order to comply with your obligations under Regulation 121B, the template should be fully populated for each reported year, and a ‘nil’ or ‘N/A’ response should be given where applicable.
- To comply with the CIL Regulations, this report should be published on your website no later than 31st December following the reported year.
- You must also send a copy of your completed report to the Waverley CIL Team, no later than 31st December following the reported year.
