## Village School achieves outstanding recognition

St. John's School was recently inspected by Ofsted, an inspection which assesses a number of areas across the school including quality of education, behaviour, leadership and management, Early Years, SEND and personal development. Ofsted awarded St. John's School a good rating in all areas. This is an excellent result for the school, against very different assessment criteria to the previous inspection 13 years ago and the leadership team are delighted with the result.

The school also underwent a second major statutory inspection, with the SIAMS inspection (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools). The school achieved the highest rating - 'Excellent' in all areas of the SIAMS inspection.

This is a truly fantastic achievement and our congratulations are extended to the school staff and governors.
